

Policy Goal: Increase Collaboration among WIOA Unified Plan Partners

- WIOA Title II includes
 - Integrated Education and Training (IET)
 - Integrated EL Civics (IELCE)
 - IELCE Plans: English language instruction, workforce preparation, and workforce training are provided concurrently
- Many IET students receive the workforce training component from the WIOA Title I partners.



Policy Goal: Increase Collaboration among WIOA Unified Plan Partners

- **AB 2098** includes measures for assessing the effectiveness of programs in immigrant integration
- There are 10 key indicators for immigrants seeking integration in workforce, civic and community life.
- Indicators include, but are not limited to - EL Civics COAAPS
- Indicators include Education and Career, English language proficiency, and economic security



IELCE: Documented Outcomes PY 18-19

- **102,429 IELCE Learners**
 - **75 %** Learners persisted
 - **54%** completed a NRS Educational Functioning Level (MSG)
 - **Civic Participation**
 - More than 75,000 IELCE learners took WIOA 243 designated Civic Objective and Additional Assessment Plans (COAAPs)
 - **90 %** passed one or more WIOA 243 designated COAAPs
 - **7,989 Learners were enrolled in IELCE with IET**
 - **54%** completed a NRS Educational Functioning Level (MSG)
 - **96 %** passed one or more WIOA 243 designated COAAPs



