

Regions Served


- Annually, BSP serves more than4,500 individuals throughoutCalifornia.

Population Served: Janitors

Janitors are Largely Immigrant

- 90% of California janitors are Latino immigrants.
- Immigrants from Mexico, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua.

Janitors are Aging

 Many Janitors have worked for 20 or even 30 years in the same job.

Janitors at Various Skill Levels

- Fewer than 30% have been formally educated beyond 6th grade.
- Most janitors have limited or non-English skills.




I pick up my kids at 3:00pm



Digital Literacy Program



- 1 Full-Time Digital Literacy Coordinator
- Development of tablet training at Google Campus for workers to communicate through web and mobile platforms 15 hours
- Blended learning model using tablets, combination of VESL and digital literacy curriculum also created in collaboration-106 hours
- Computer courses focusing on email, Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.
- 5 Smartphone classes at BSP offices focusing on apps for health, banking, email, social media, etc.
- Partnerships with LATTC, Janitorial Contractors, Client Companies such as Google, CellEd and Mobile UP
